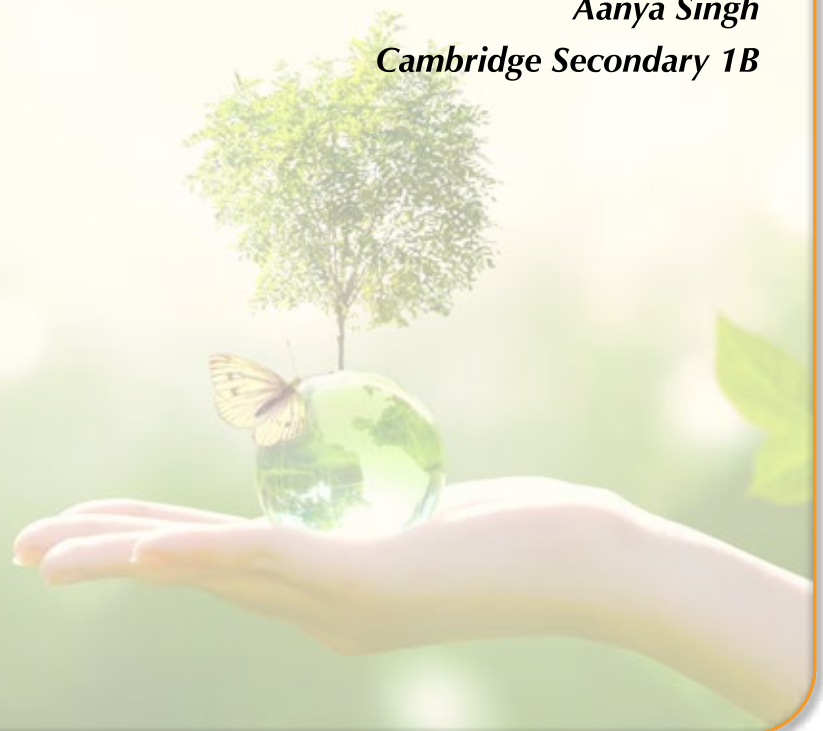
GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE

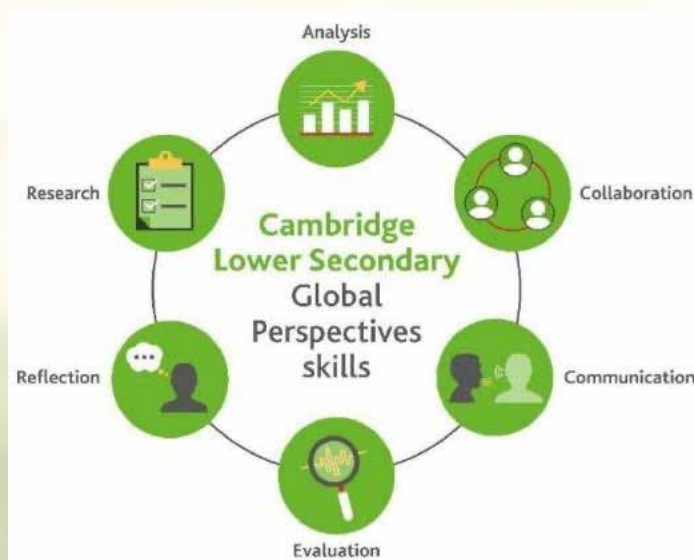

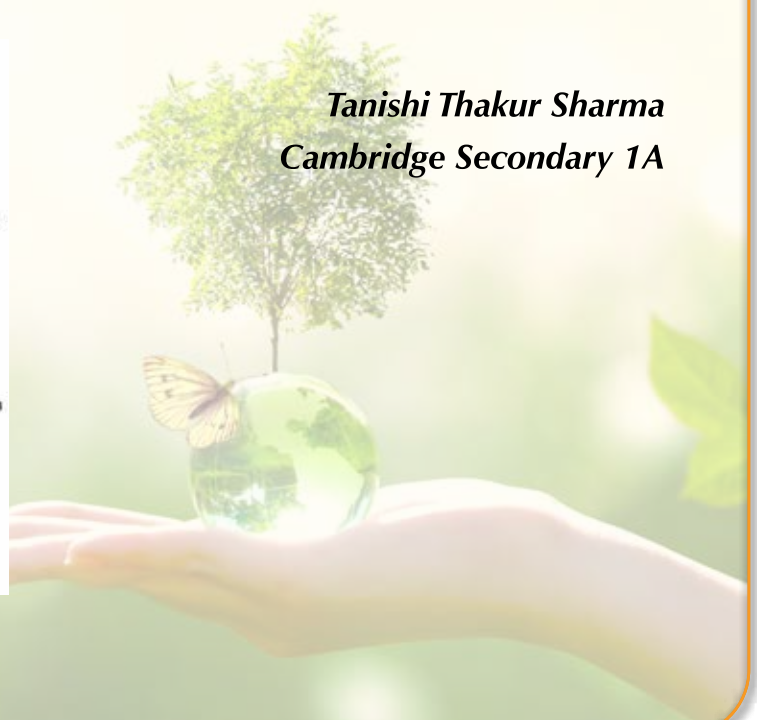

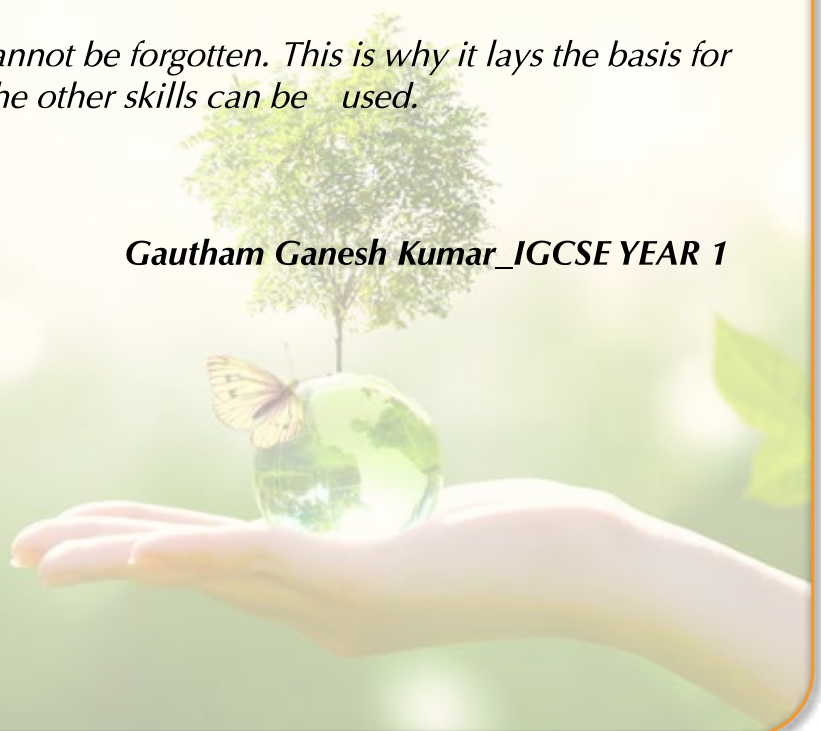
The Oxford definition of Communication is “the imparting or exchanging of information by speaking, writing, or using some other medium” (Oxford Languages, n.d.).
