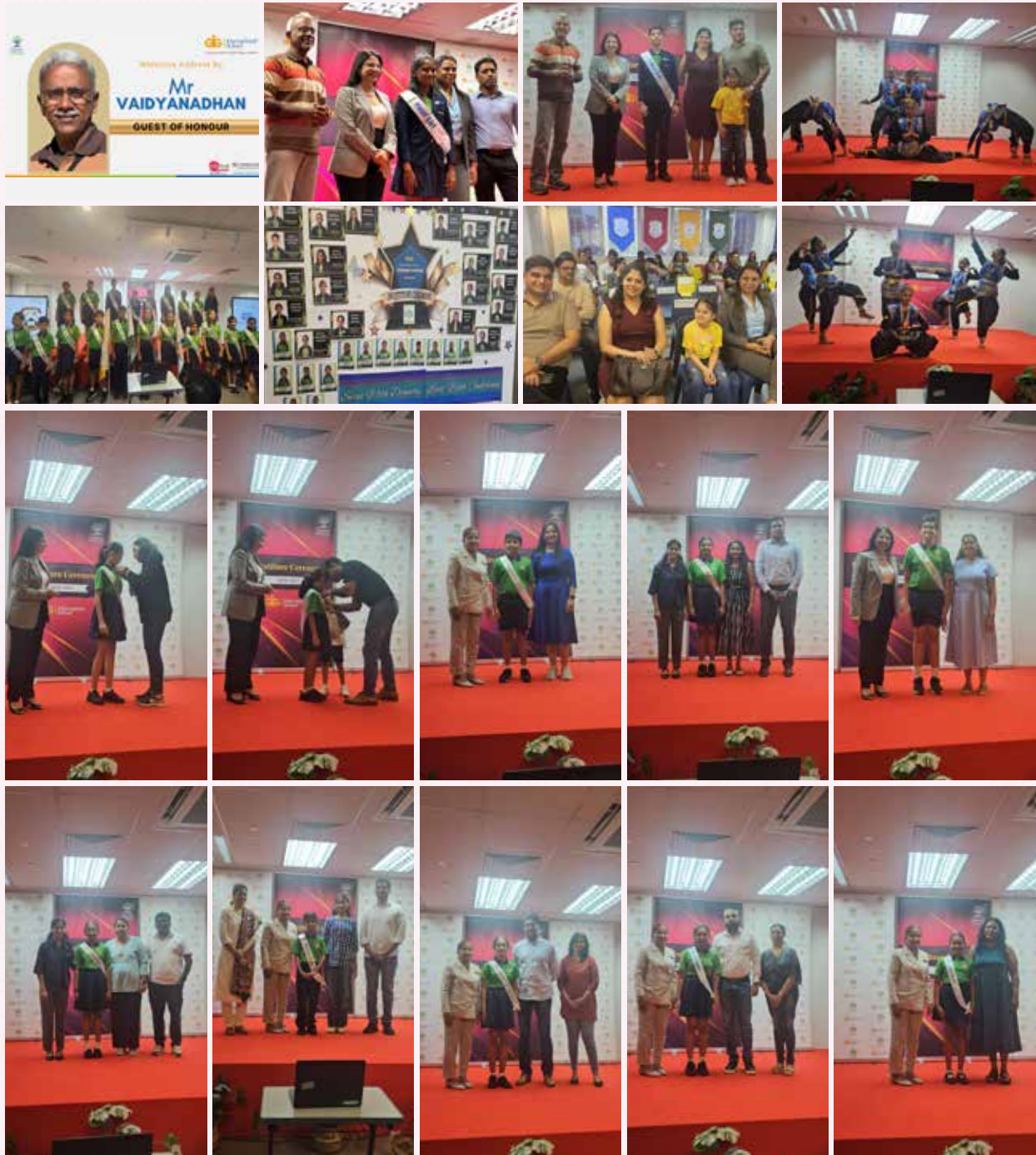

PROJECT E.C.O. 2025: GIG WINS SILVER AWARD FOR PUBLIC HEALTH

GIG International School is proud to have been awarded the **Silver Award** in the **Project E.C.O. 2025 (Public Health Category)** for the Secondary Level, in recognition of our students' outstanding efforts in promoting environmental and public health education.

Through their project, "**Beat the Bite**," our students addressed the growing concern of dengue by raising awareness within the school and wider community. After identifying gaps in dengue prevention knowledge through surveys, the team launched a creative and impactful campaign featuring an original dengue awareness rap, an educational podcast, informative posters, class presentations, and community outreach activities. By collaborating with other schools and engaging neighbourhood residents, they successfully encouraged collective action against dengue.

Beyond increasing awareness of dengue prevention, the project also strengthened students' leadership, communication, and teamwork skills while inspiring lasting community engagement. To ensure the initiative continues to make an impact, the team shared their resources with junior students, uploaded educational materials to school platforms, and proposed regular Dengue Awareness Weeks for future cohorts.
